Requirements for the

Major in Women's, Gender and Sexuality Studies

Core Courses: Students are required to take:

- One 1000/100 level WS Introductory Course (WS 1104/104, WS 1105/105 or WS 1124/124)
- WS 3265W/265W – WS Research Methodology
- WS 3250/250 – Feminisms
- WS 3891/261 – WS Internship
- WS 3894/262 – Intern Seminar
- WS 4994W/289W – Senior Seminar in WS

Supporting Courses: In addition to core courses, students are required to take five Supporting Courses.

Majors must complete at least 15 credits of 2000/3000/200 level courses that should be selected with the guidance of their faculty advisor. At least three of these courses will be Women's Studies or cross-listed courses. Two of the five supporting courses may include cross-referenced courses that cover special topics relevant to feminist scholarship in various departments. Such cross-referenced courses will be applied to the major with approval of the Program Director.

Related Courses: Students must take an additional 12 credits at the 2000/3000/200 level or above in fields closely related to the major. No required course in the major or in the related area may be taken pass/fail.

Requirements for the

Minor in Women's, Gender and Sexuality Studies

- Fifteen credit hours in Women's Studies and cross-listed courses, of which one course may be at the 1000/100 level.
- No more than two courses may be counted toward both the Major and the Minor.
- The Women's Studies Internship Program (WS 3891/261 and 3894/262) will count for a maximum of six credits toward the Minor.
- Students should contact the Women's Studies Program office for advising. Students must have the approval of their advisor and the Women's Studies Program Director.
